2020 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The 2020 Sacramento Adult Buddhist Association (SABA) Scholarship Program offers academic financial assistance for a total of \$1000. This award is made possible by the generous donation from the SABA.

Graduating high school students who will be attending college or student currently attending an accredited college, university or vocational school in 2020-2021 may apply for the scholarship. The student's parent(s), family member or student must be a member of the Sacramento Buddhist Church or Sacramento Adult Buddhist Association.

The Scholarship award is based on a competitive process that includes an application, essay and an oral interview. This award is to help fund education or training after high school by recognizing students who are actively involved in **community service**.

The evaluation criteria will be:

- Your active involvement in community, school and Sacramento Buddhist Church activities
- Scholastic achievement
- Essay – at least one page and not more than 3 pages
- Oral interview

The scholarship committee will place a heavier weight on activities and responsibilities performed with SABA, for example; assist with golf tournament, Services, dinners, dance, bazaar, etc.
