- And if they decide not to go to college, switch to eligible beneficiaries at no cost.

ScholarShare529 is the California State administered 529 Savings Plan endorsed by the Sacramento Buddhist Church and ABA.

ABA Scholarship Education Fund

Annual Contributions to Dharma School Students' 529 Savings Accounts are made by the ABA Scholarship Education Fund. This Fund is intended for Scholarship and Education Programs of Betsuin Youth. Contributions to the Fund are considered tax-exempt donations to the Sacramento Buddhist Church.

Eligibility Requirements

The Owner of the 529 Account must be a Family Member of the Buddhist Church of Sacramento, ABA or the Eligible Beneficiary.

The Beneficiary of the 529 Savings Account must be a current school year student in Pre-School or K-12th Grade and a member of Dharma School, Betsuin Sports Program, Betsuin-Sponsored Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Sakura Gakuen, or Jr. YBA.
